

DIRECTIONS TO CHRISTENING AND SAILING

BABY MARINA CHRISTENING AT TOMAHAWK BAY MARINA

Coming from Portland, take I-5 North. Exit at the Jantzen Beach exit, keep right at the fork, and go straight through the intersection where the Chevron is to your left and the Safeway is on your right. Go straight and head east on Tomahawk Island Drive. Go approx. 1.2 miles. The road will curve sharply left at Sundance Marina. Follow it left, and drive straight into the parking lot in front of Building 1 at Tomahawk Bay Marina. There is a big green lawn to the east of the parking lot, near the BBQ and picnic tables. That's where Marina will be Christened.

BRAD'S BOAT "LILY" AT HAYDEN BAY EAST FROM TOMAHAWK BAY

Coming from the Christening at Tomahawk Bay, go back the way you came, traveling West on Tomahawk Island Drive. Just before Lotus Isle Park, turn Right into Lotus Beach Drive (.5 miles), then turn right immediately into the marina parking lot. Walk through the tunnel to the marina. Either wait at the gate to sneak in when someone comes or goes (Friday afternoons are pretty busy), or call Brad at 503.860.4560 and he'll come open the door. Slip number B-1, to the left at the bottom of the ramp.

BRAD'S BOAT "LILY" AT HAYDEN BAY EAST FROM PORTLAND

Coming from Portland, take the Jantzen Beach exit, keep right, head east on Tomahawk Island Drive, go past Lotus Isle Park on your right, turn left into the next street, Lotus Beach Drive, then turn right immediately into the marina parking lot. Walk through the tunnel to the marina. Either wait at the gate to sneak in when someone comes or goes (Friday afternoons are pretty busy), or call Brad at 503.860.4560 and he'll come open the door. Slip number B-1, to the left at the bottom of the ramp. (Brad doesn't mind if you bring red wine and any sort of provisions.)

PHIL'S BOAT "MIRA" AT HAYDEN BAY WEST FROM TOMAHAWK BAY

Coming from the Christening at Tomahawk Bay, go back the way you came, traveling West on Tomahawk Island Drive. Drive approx. 1 mile. Across from the Fire station look for North Hayden Bay Drive. Turn right, go 500 meters and look for a gate marked 420 River House. The gate should be open, or there is a key hidden up high to the left of the gate. Call Anna or Phil if you can't get in, 503-789-0586 or 971-246-2603. Walk straight down the paved path and down the ramp, where you will see Mira directly below. (Phil prefers you don't bring red wine because it stains the deck.)

PHIL'S BOAT "MIRA" AT HAYDEN BAY WEST FROM PORTLAND

Coming from Portland, take I-5 North. RETURNING TO PORTLAND FROM YOUR SAILING ADVENTURES ON TOMAHAWK ISLAND

Travel West on Tomahawk Island Drive. At the intersection with the Chevron on the right and the Safeway on the left, turn Left. The road curves around past Hooters, and dips under an overpass. Follow the road around and look for signs for I-5 South.

A NOTE ABOUT DRIVING ON I-5 AFTER 3 PM

It gets totally jammed. If the highway is bad, exit at Killingsworth, turn left, and go up Denver or Interstate Avenue to the end, where it will spit you onto a secret ramp onto I-5.
